



CORNELIUS DUFFIE GUILD

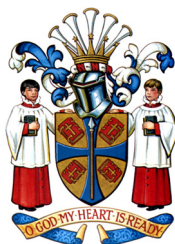
The Cornelius Duffie Guild of the Saint Thomas Planned Giving Society was founded in 2009 to recognize those people who have put Saint Thomas Church or Choir School in their estate plans.

Throughout its history, Saint Thomas has benefitted greatly from bequests and other types of planned gifts, and it is in an effort to acknowledge, thank and remember these thoughtful donors, that the Rector, the Wardens, and the Vestry founded the Cornelius Duffie Guild.

All donors of bequests and planned gifts are invited to join the Cornelius Duffie Guild and unless anonymity is requested, the members will be listed in the Yearbook and possibly in other published acknowledgments. From time to time, the Guild will hold special events for its members.

This important recognition society was named after the much beloved Cornelius Roosevelt Duffie, who in 1823, at the age of thirty-five became the first Rector of Saint Thomas Church. Mr. Duffie was born in New York City in 1789 and educated at Episcopal Academy in Cheshire, Connecticut, and at Columbia College. Under his leadership, the Vestry decided to build a church, in the Gothic style, at the corner of Houston Street and Broadway. In 1827, within a year after the consecration of this church, Cornelius Duffie died of typhoid fever at the age of thirty-eight.
