Her diverse engagements have included organ recitals at The Cathédrale Saint-Pierre in Poitiers, France and Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart (NJ), an operatic accompanying performance at the Douglaston Concert Series (NY), and a ballet performance at Bryant Park Summer Concerts (NYC). Upcoming and recent performances include some of the most formidable venues in the United States: St. Mary the Virgin, a performance that was subsequently featured on American Public Radio's Pipedreams; St. Bartholomew's Church (NYC); St. Paul's Episcopal (Chattanooga, Tenn). In June of 2009, Ms. Meloan performed at the Spoleto Festival in Charleston, South Carolina to critical acclaim. In addition to gracing the musical stage, Ms. Meloan is also a classical dancer. She has danced with Ballet Long Island, Staten Island Ballet, and currently she is artistic director/dancer of Bridal Ballet. Currently, Katherine is a doctoral candidate in organ performance at Manhattan School of Music where she is a recipient of the distinguished Bronson Ragan Award in outstanding musical performance.
