#### THE CHOIR

The Saint Thomas Choir of Men and Boys is considered to be the leading ensemble of its kind in the Anglican choral tradition in the United States. While its primary *raison d'être* is to sing five choral services each week, the Choir also performs regularly with Orchestra of St. Luke's and New York Baroque Incorporated as part of St. Thomas Church concert series. Live webcasts of choral services and further information concerning recordings, tours and concerts given by the Choir can be found at <u>www.SaintThomasChurch.org</u>.

Over recent years, the Choir has toured throughout the U.S., Europe and Scandinavia with performances at Westminster Abbey and St. Paul's Cathedral in London, King's College, Cambridge, Windsor, Edinburgh, St. Albans, the Aldeburgh Festival and the Vatican. In 2012, the Boys of the Choir traveled to Dresden to give the premiere of Lera Auerbach's *Dresden Requiem* with the Dresden Staatskapelle in the Frauenkirche and Semper Oper and the full choir performed later that year in the Thomaskirche at the Leipzig *BachFest*. Domestically, the Choir most recently toured the Southern United States.

Besides the annual performances of Handel's Messiah, concerts at Saint Thomas Church have included Requiems by Fauré, Brahms, Mozart, Duruflé, Victoria and Howells; J.S. Bach's Passions, Mass in B Minor and Motets; the lesser-known St. John Passion of C.P.E. Bach; the U.S. premiere of John Tavener's Mass; the U.S. premiere of Nico Muhly's work My Days with viol consort Fretwork; Handel's Israel in Egypt and James MacMillan's Seven Last Words from the Cross. In 2014, the Boy Choristers performed in Bach's Saint Matthew Passion at the Park Avenue Armory as part of Lincoln Center's White Light Festival with the Berliner Philharmoniker under the direction of Peter Sellars and conductor Sir Simon Rattle. In 2016, a concert in memory of John Scott was performed with Orchestra of St. Luke's under the direction of Sir Simon Rattle.

The Gentlemen of the Saint Thomas Choir are professional singers; the Boy Choristers attend the Saint Thomas Choir School and The Saint Thomas Choir of Men and Boys is represented by Karen McFarlane Artists, Inc. (www.concertorganists.com).

## ABOUT THE ORGANS

The Irene D. and William R. Miller Chancel Organ in memory of John Scott was completed in September 2018, built and installed by Dobson Pipe Organ Builders Ltd, from Lake City, Iowa. Comprising 102 speaking stops, the instrument is situated on both sides of the church, above the choir stalls. Offering a fully 'American' and eclectic palette of colors, from the softest sounds to the ear-splittingly loud, the instrument has been designed to showcase both the solo and choral-liturgical repertoire for which Saint Thomas Church is justly famed. As the brain-child of the late John Scott, the instrument reflects something in sound of the detailed beauty seen elsewhere in the Church's stone and glass. The new case seen to the left of the reredos was designed in collaboration with Dennis Collier of Pennsylvania; the ornate carvings and the inscription 'Soli Deo Gloria' reflect the ethos of the Church, and all the music that is offered within our liturgies to the greater glory of God.

In the spring of 1996 the gallery instrument was dedicated as the *Loening-Hancock Organ*. The firm of Taylor & Boody of Staunton, Virginia, built the instrument which contained twenty-one stops over two manuals and pedal. In January 2016, the organ was expanded to three manuals and pedal, with the addition of ten new stops. The instrument is inspired by the tradition of organ building which was active in the Netherlands and North Germany in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. Stop and key action are mechanical and the temperament is Kellner.

The Martha J. Dodge Continuo Organ was built and initiated in December, 2001. This superb portative instrument, consisting of 4 ranks of pipes, was built by the firm of Taylor & Boody.
