Reading: Philippians 2:1-11 Theme: Living a Jesus Christ Shaped Life

The ancient Christian hymn in Philippians 2 contains a **call to unity and humility for the church** - a **community of the Holy Spirit which is** enemy of division and party-spirit.

The sign that we are our Lord's disciples is in **Living a Jesus Christ shaped life in** unity with others with the same love for one another and a common attitude of mind' (Philippians 2: 2). Doing everything as unto the Lord, and as if in his full gaze. **This is living a Jesus Christ shaped life**.

Jesus Christ, is the Good Shepherd whose sheep follow him "because they know his voice", 'And so, a true minister, a true disciple can dare to say to others: "Follow me, as I am following Jesus".

What matters is that people should grow in holiness, wisdom and love. For the life of Jesus Christ was not written: it was lived. And that is the secret of every witness, every disciple, every minister of Jesus Christ – that the life of the Good Shepherd is being lived in them. So we too need to Live a Jesus Christ shaped life - helping others, to flourish both in things of the earth and in matters of the Holy Spirit.

For we are members of a body, which requires that every part should be in harmony with the whole, no-one considering themselves better than others.

Jesus Christ: "was in the form of God; yet he laid no claim to equality with God, but made himself nothing, assuming the form of a slave. (Philippians 2:6-7). —We lose nothing by nurturing this spirit of humility, for he was honoured in the end. None of us is the centre of the universe. Jesus Christ is.

That is why in **living a Jesus Christ shaped life**, we learn that **the way to ascend is to descend**. "He who would be chief must be willing to be the servant of all" (Mark 10:43 -44).

May this Mission Unit of St. Thomas Church Fifth Avenue, New York, as a community of the Holy Spirit, think, reflect, and act, attending to the whole of Scripture and to Scripture as a whole seeing how the New Testament is proclaiming the fulfilment of the gracious promises of the Old. Living in unity and humility, in a Jesus-Christ-shaped way so that people will ask, 'what manner of people are these who love each other implicitly. And we can answer - They are living Lives that are Jesus Christ shaped'.
