From 2011-2016 he was an adjunct lecturer in Hunter College's music department, and since 2010 he has also been Assistant Conductor for the Greenwich Choral Society in Connecticut. He is the Dean of the New York City Chapter of the American Guild of Organists and a board member of the Catholic Artists Society and the New York Purgatorial Society. A graduate of the Juilliard School and the Manhattan School of Music, his private teachers have included Paul Jacobs (organ) and Robert Page and Kent Tritle (conducting).
