The Celebrant says the preface

... evermore praising thee, and saying,

HOLY, holy, holy, Lord God of Hosts. Glory be to thee, O Lord most High.

Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

Where possible, we kneel.

The Celebrant continues the Eucharistic Prayer, which concludes

...world without end.

The People respond AMEN.

## The Lord's Prayer

#### The Celebrant says

And now, as our Savior Christ hath taught us, we are bold to say,

### Celebrant and People

UR Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread.

And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.

The Celebrant breaks the consecrated bread. (The Alleluia is omitted in Lent).

Celebrant [Alleluia.] Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us;People Therefore let us keep the feast. [Alleluia.]

LAMB of God, that takest away the sins of the world, have mercy upon us. O Lamb of God, that takest away the sins of the world, have mercy upon us. O Lamb of God, that takest away the sins of the world, grant us thy peace.

#### **Invitation to Communion**

BEHOLD the Lamb of God: behold him that taketh away the sins of the world. Blessed are those who are called to his supper.

People Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof, but speak the word only and my soul shall be healed.

## **Holy Communion**

All baptized Christians are invited to receive Holy Communion. The Sacrament is distributed at the Crossing. Intinction is not permitted. You are welcome to receive in one kind only. Gluten free hosts available - please ask the priest.

## The Prayer after Communion

#### Celebrant and People

LMIGHTY and everliving God, we most  $oldsymbol{\Lambda}$  heartily thank thee for that thou dost feed us, in these holy mysteries, with the spiritual food of the most precious Body and Blood of thy Son our Savior Jesus Christ; and dost assure us thereby of thy favor and goodness towards us; and that we are very members incorporate in the mystical body of thy Son, the blessed company of all faithful people; and are also heirs, through hope, of thy everlasting kingdom. And we humbly beseech thee, O heavenly Father, so to assist us with thy grace, that we may continue in that holy fellowship, and do all such good works as thou hast prepared for us to walk in; through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honor and glory, world without end. Amen.

The Celebrant blesses the people and then says the dismissal.
