This past summer, Jerrick won first prize in the American Guild of Organists' National Competition in Organ Improvisation. Other accolades include second prize in the National Competition in Organ Accompaniment sponsored by the Washington, DC chapter of the AGO and third prize in the Quebec Organ Competition in Quebec City, Canada. Also an active composer, Jerrick's choral music has been performed by choirs around the globe and was recently featured in Oxford University Press' latest edition of Carols for Choirs 6.
